

## Bi-Monthly Traffic Management Report

Published July 2023 – for May and June 2023 traffic

In accordance with Schedule 3 Condition 2.3 of the Mayfield Concept Plan (MCP) Approval, projects associated with the Concept Plan shall not exceed the total truck movement limits presented in Table 1 below, subject to identified exceptions which will be considered in future project assessments:

Table 1: Mayfield Concept Approval Truck Movement Criteria for Initial Stage

Permitted Truck Movements Per Annum	462,104
Permitted Truck Movements per day	1,268
Permitted Hourly Truck Movements in Peak Periods	95

To ensure compliance with these provisions, PON requires tenants and licensees operating under the MCP Approval to provide truck movement information on a bi-monthly schedule. There are currently two projects operating under the MCP Approval:

- Stolthaven SSD 6664, commencing May 2016
- Mayfield Cargo Storage Facility DA 8137, commencing July 2017

Total truck movements per annum are reported using a rolling cumulative total over the preceding 12-month period. The total daily truck movements are reported using a per day average across the twelve-month period. The total hourly truck movements during peak periods is reported using worst case data averaged over the twelve-month period.

Figures 1, 2 and 3 compare actual truck movements with the permitted total, showing all criteria has been met during the reporting period.

[Rolling Cumulative Total]

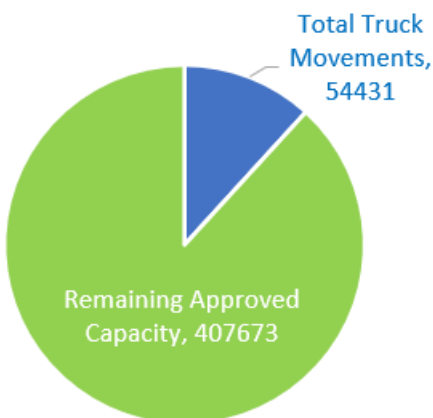


Figure 2: Daily Truck Movements  
[Average, June 2023]

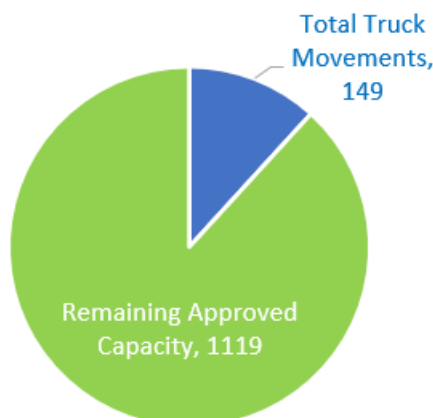


Figure 3: Peak Period Truck Movements
